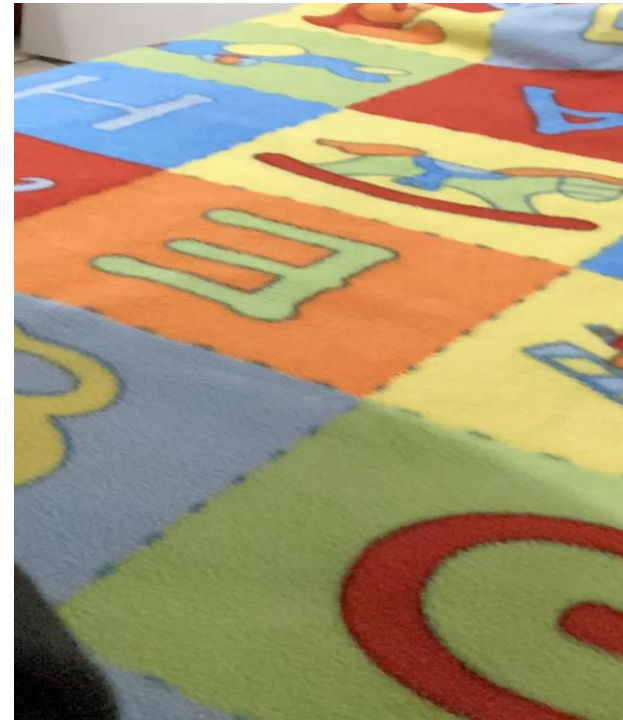
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HOW TO SEW A CIRCULAR CAT BED

A blanket that you no longer need can be used to make this Circular Cat Bed. I made it off a blanket that was used by my Son when he was little.

This is useful to have for those cold nights for your cat to snuggle up.

This easy to follow tutorial will show you how to sew a Circular Cat Bed in just a few minutes.



TOOLS

Sewing machine

Iron and ironing board



STEP 1: ORGANISE FABRIC AND CUT OUT

Before you start, you need to organise your fabric and tools.

1. Fold your blanket into four and mark 40cm on both ends, connect the ends with a circular line and cut it out.
2. Do the same for the lining, you can use a bed sheet for this.



STEP 2: TWO PIECES CUT OUT

1. The blanket circle for the top
2. A plain cotton fabric for the lining



STEP 3: GET SEWING

1. Sew the two circles facing right sides. Leave a 7½ cm gap to insert the filling.
2. Turn inside out and press.
3. Mark 12½ cm from the outer circle down to form an inner circle. Sew around the inner circle, leaving a 7½ cm gap to insert the filling.



INSERT THE FILLING

1. Insert the filling to the inner circle and sew the gap.
2. Insert the filling to the outer circle and sew the gap.



COMPLETED CIRCULAR CAT BED

Your Circular Cat Bed is complete and ready for your Cat to snuggle up.
